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Board approves offering home for sale

The Hutchinson Public Schools Board of Education Monday (May 23, 2016) took the first steps to sell the 2015-16 Building Trades Program home.

The Board formally declared the house as “surplus” allowing it to be sold. The asking price for the home will be \$285,000. The asking price was based on three separate market analyses.

Located at 2809 Morris Street on Hutchinson northwest side, the district will attempt to sell the home without contracting a Realtor initially by posting sale information in The Hutchinson News and on district social media.

In other action, the Board:

- Approved the purchase of Cisco Network equipment.
- Approved the Reno County Early Head Start grant with the Kansas Department for Children and Families.
