Board approves administrative salaries

The Hutchinson Public Schools Board of Education Monday, Nov. 13, 2017, approved a 5 percent increase in administrative compensation for the current school year.

Action came after an executive session on personnel and negotiations. The Board earlier this fall approved a similar increase in the compensation package for classified (hourly) employees.

The Board continues to negotiate with NEA-Hutchinson on the 2017-18 professional agreement. The next negotiations session between the district and NEA-Hutchinson is set for Nov. 29.

- Approved the monitoring report for Results 2 – English Language Arts.
