## Board prepares to put Trades house on market

The Hutchinson Public Schools Board of Education Monday (June 12, 2017) took the first steps to selling a home built by the Building Trades Program.

The home, at 2813 Morris on Hutchinson's northwest side, was constructed by Hutchinson Career and Technical Education Academy and Hutchinson Community College students during the 2016-17 school year. Each year, the program builds a single family home, which is sold and the proceeds used to fund the home built the next year.

Based on market analysis, the asking price for the home will be \$280,000. Monday's USD 308 Board action was to declare the property as "surplus," giving the district permission to sell it.
