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eBoard Notes
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Board closes out 2016-17

The Hutchinson Public Schools Board of Education formally closed out the 2016-17 school year Monday (June 26, 2017). Included in the end-of-year work were final budget transfers for the district.

As stewards of public funds, the district staff avoid overspending from year to year. With thousands of budget lines, however, small amounts of money often are left in the lines. These small amounts must be transferred to areas that can have a carryover or the district loses its ability to spend the money.

Additionally, the district also has to transfer money into funds – such as special education – that do not receive federal dollars until after Oct. 1 to fund those programs temporarily.

In other action, the Board:

- Approved minutes of the June 12, 2017, Board meeting.
- Received a fundraiser report for the 2016-17 school year. About \$253,000 was raised for the district schools by various fund raising events, which was \$9,000 more than in 2015-16.
- Waived the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles for 2016-17 and 2017-18. Most governmental units in Kansas waive GAAP because a GAAP audit is significantly more expensive than a regular government audit. The district saves about \$15,000 each year by the waiver.
- Approved the Reno County Head Start/Early Head Start supplemental grant application.
- Approved the Early Head Start Interagency Agreement with the Reno County Health Department to provide prenatal services for Early Head Start.
- Approved a program agreement between Head Start and ABC Counseling, LLC, to provide services.
- Approved the purchase of i-Ready Instruction for the 2017-18 school year.
- Approved the Early Learning Kansas consolidated state preschool grant for 2017-18.

- Approved the purchase of iPad apps for elementary English language arts and math.
- Approved the purchase of leveled literacy intervention training for staff and eight intervention kits.
- Approved the purchase of Greg Tang Math Centers materials and training.
- Approved the Kansas Parenting Education Program Grant, which formerly was known as the Parents as Teacher grant, for 2017-18.
- Approved the Treasurer's Report for May 2017.
- Assigned Board members 2017-18 handbooks to review. The Board will approve district and building handbooks at the July 10 Board meeting.
- Set 8 to 11 a.m. on July 8 as the annual retreat for the Board at the Administration Center.
