## Policy Type: Operational Expectations

## **Learning Environment**

The Superintendent shall establish and maintain a learning environment that is respectful and conducive to high achievement, which shall include a system of positive behavior supports and enforcement of discipline policies to maintain safe and orderly environments for all students.

## The Superintendent will:

- 1. Maintain a climate that is characterized by support and encouragement for high student achievement.
- 2. Appropriately involve teachers, administrators, students and the community in the systems for principles of positive support and disciplinary actions for unsafe or disruptive student behavior.
- 3. Ensure implementation of positive behavior supports and enforcement of discipline policies and procedures are consistent.
- 4. Manage information in such ways that confidential information is protected.
- 5. Maintain a learning environment that values student differences.
- 6. Maintain a learning environment that is respectful, responsive, and welcoming.

## The Superintendent will prohibit:

- 7. Unlawful student behaviors that disrupt learning. Prohibited behaviors include the following:
  - a. the use of drugs, alcohol or tobacco products by students on school property and at school-sponsored events;
  - b. the presence of firearms and other dangerous weapons on school property and at school-sponsored events;
  - c. bullying, disrespect or violence on school property and at school-sponsored events.
