Kansas Insurance for Children:

1. **KanCare:** Includes Medical, Dental, Mental Illness and Substance Abuse services. Applications are available at the Reno County Health Department.
2. **Kan-Be-Healthy:** A program for children and young adults under the age of 21 years who are covered under the title 19 program (Medicaid). If your child has a medical card, he/she is entitled to regular physical exams. The program pays for costs. Apply at the SRS office/ 600 Andrew St./ South Hutchinson/ 663-5731
