K-12 Information Fact Sheet**

1) **Immunization Requirements** In accordance with The Kansas School Immunization Law (K.S.A. 72-5209 and K.A.R. 28-1-20), USD 308 requires all students receive the most appropriate inoculations in the required series unless there is a medical or religious exemption. Please refer to the Kansas Immunization Schedule for age specific requirements.

*\*Students without current immunizations or exemption status shall be excluded from school.*

2) On an **annual** basis a **District Health Information Form** should be completed and returned to the school nurse. All required forms related to health conditions from the physician and parents can be accessed at <http://www.usd308.com/node/24>.

3) **Administration of Medication in the School Setting**

Please refer to the District’s Medication Guidelines. If your child requires medication to be given at school it is the parent/guardian responsibility to provide medication and appropriate paperwork completed to school nurse. OTC medications must meet age requirements as recommended. ***Prescription medications require a doctor’s signature.***

4) **Health Assessment Form (Physical)**

All students up to the age of nine (9) shall submit evidence they have undergone a health assessment prior to entering kindergarten or before enrolling in the district for the first time. Students without such evidence shall provide one (1) of the following as per K.S.A. 72-5214: 1) a written statement signed by one parent or guardian that the child is an adherent of a religious denomination whose religious teachings are opposed to such assessments; or 2) a written statement signed by one parent or guardian that such assessment will be scheduled and completed within 90 days after admission to school.

- District personnel will complete basic hearing and vision screening tests on students according to state guideline requirements.
- Parents/guardians will be notified of the testing results and as applicable recommendation for follow-up evaluation.

7) **Identification**

All students enrolling in the district for the first time shall provide a certified copy of their birth certificate, a certified copy of the court order placing the child in the custody of the Secretary of the Department for Children and Families, Social Security identification card, baptismal certificate or other documentation approved by the Superintendent. Students enrolling in grades 2 through 12 also shall provide a certified transcript or similar pupil record from the school or school district the student attended most recently.

8) **Phone Numbers**

Whenever needed please let the school know of changes in contact names or phone numbers. Having current information will assist the school to reach either the parent/guardian or emergency contact should the student experience an illness or accident.
