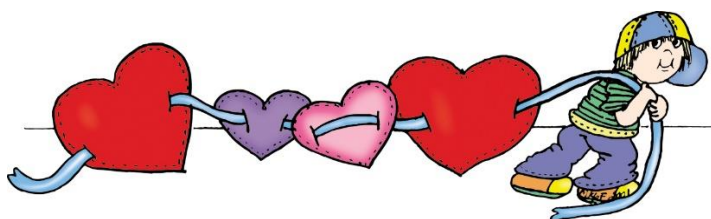


6th Grade
