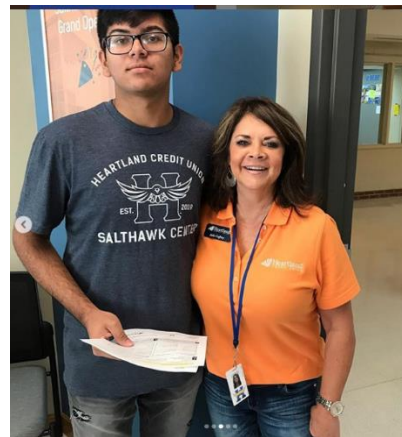

- Student accounts cannot be overdrawn. If funds are not available, the card will be declined.
- Student interns will present to Personal Finance classes on financial literacy topics.
- Personal Finance students will experience a trimester long lab *Real World Classroom* that requires them to manage real world financial decisions. This simulation is in supplement to the Dave Ramsey curriculum used in the course.
