Communities That Care connects caring adult volunteers from the community with students in our schools. These volunteers serve as lunch buddies, academic coaches, career advisors and mentors to specially selected students. All Communities That Care Mentor volunteers are screened and trained. Your child has been invited to interact with a Communities That Care Mentor volunteer for one hour per week during the school day. The hour chosen is selected by the teacher and will not interfere with schoolwork. The activities are recommended by the teacher and support staff, matching the interests and needs of the student with the experience and skills of the Communities That Care Mentor volunteer. The only time volunteers and students meet at a location other than the school is an activity that has been approved by the school and is supervised by school staff according to regular school district policy. In order to begin this effort, we must have your permission. Please complete the form below and return it to the school immediately. Once we receive the form, we will start your child in this worthwhile experience.
