## Board approves sale of Building Trades home

The Hutchinson Public Schools Board of Education Monday (Aug. 22, 2016) approved the sale of the Building Trades home constructed during the 2015-16 school year.

The Hutchinson Career and Technical Education Academy normally builds a residential home in the district. Proceeds from the sale of the previous year's home are used to help fund the following year's home.

Students from Hutchinson High School, Hutchinson Community College and area high schools who are in the HCTEA Building Trades program build the house under the direction of staff. The sale closes in November.
